Intro. In light of all of our struggles in life, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph are examples of wrestling by faith.

I. Isaac Blessed His Sons “blindly” (Heb. 11:20; Gen. 27)

- A. Wrestling by Faith acknowledges our Limited vision
- B. Wrestling by Faith assumes our Liable vulnerability

II. Jacob Blessed Joseph’s Sons bravely (Heb. 11:21; Gen. 48-49)

- C. Wrestling by Faith admits to Limited strength
- D. Wrestling by Faith is awareness of difficulties

III. Joseph Pre-Arranged His Second burial! (Heb. 11:22; Gen. 49:29-33; 50)

- A. Wrestling by Faith allows God’s purpose to be Accomplished (50:15-21)
- B. Wrestling by Faith anticipates Future blessings
(50:22- 26)
