 - B. Winning by Faith Involves Being Rewarded by Goodness of God

(Josh. 6:25; Heb. 11:31; Matt. 1:5)

- III. From the Rest of the Heroes of Faith We Learn...(Heb. 11:32-39)A. Winning by Faith Can Include <u>Experiencing</u> Incredible <u>Accomplishments</u> of God (11:32-35)
 - B. Winning by Faith Can Include Enduring Incredible Atrocities of Men (11:35-39)
