# In your moments of <u>despair</u>, Jesus is <u>there</u>

#### 1. Jesus not only comes, He sees (vs. 11-13a)

- A. He has the ability to see you
- B. He sees you in the <u>crowd</u>

## 2. Jesus not only sees, He is moved by compassion (vs. 13)

- A. He is moved by your needs
- B. He does respond to your needs

#### 3. Jesus is not only moved, He speaks (vs. 13)

- A. He says what no one else will
- B. He says what no one else can

## 4. Jesus not only speaks, He reaches out (vs. 14)

- A. He is willing to reach out to the <u>defiled</u>
- B. He is willing to reach out to the <u>dead</u>

## 5. Jesus not only reaches out, He <u>changes</u> everything

(vs. 14b-17)

- A. He changes the <u>situation</u> of the hurting
- B. He changes the focus of the faithful
- C. He changes the opinion of the skeptical
