They attack this doctrine because they consider it the weakest stone in the structure of a supernatural, revealed religion. They know that the fundamental truths of our faith stand or fall together. By dislodging this stone, they hope that the entire edifice will be weakened and will ultimately fall. We should defend it for the same reason that the modernists attack it. Revealed truth does stand or fall together. If we sacrifice this doctrine, the whole structure of our faith will be undermined, and will be in danger of total collapse."
